HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

E-NEWSLETTER

To become part of the Family Network, join the e-newsletter mailing list! You'll receive a monthly e-newsletter to keep you up to date on what's going on at SSCY, and regular invites to special events and programs hosted by the Family Network.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The Family Network hosts several special events each year for families, based on needs identified in the community. Past events have included guest speakers, a recreation opportunities expo, and a self-care event for caregivers.

REGULAR PROGRAMS

PARENT TO PARENT CAFE

The Cafe is a support group for parents of children with additional needs, led by parents. This open group meets monthly and covers a variety of topics based on needs identified by the parents that participate.

SIBSHOPS

Sibshops are for siblings ages 7-12 of children with additional needs. At these groups, siblings will meet other sibs, have fun, laugh, talk about the good and not-so-good parts of having a sib with additional needs, play some great games, learn something about the services their brothers and sisters receive, and have some more fun! This program runs at different times throughout the year.

POWERFUL TOOLS FOR CAREGIVERS

This 6-week program is designed to provide caregivers with tools to support them in taking care of themselves while also caring for others. This course is designed specifically for caregivers of children and teens with additional needs. This course runs twice a year.
