We invite you to participate in our study and share your experiences of neurodiversity through story. Working with families, we created an interactive knowledge sharing platform "Collaboration Station" to understand & support the experiences of neurodiverse families. This living lab is a collaborative platform used to conduct and share research in a meaningful way. Our aim is to create a user registry of families who can share their stories of neurodiversity and learn from the stories of others. We will share these findings through an arts-based knowledge translation resource.

Who can participate

- Neurodiverse youth age 5-19 years old who have accessed services at the SSCY Centre (Specialized Services for Children and Youth)
- The siblings and parents/legal guardians of youth who meet above criteria

Participation involves

- Create a user profile in the Collaboration Station platform
- Complete a minimum of 1 story entry per month for 6 months in the Collaboration Station living lab platform

Participants receive:

- \$20 per story entry (up to 6 entries).
